They were missionaries from Gualtemala and we talk d for over an hour. It became apparent that one of the reasons we were at Sun-n-Fun to get out the word that Chuck was looking for a pilot to serve in Guatemala. Had we not followed God's calling and served His will by staying at Sun-n-Fun when everyone around us was leaving, we wouldn't have received the blessing of meeting Chuck and Robin. - 5. Present Chapter operating certificate at the ceremony

Through this entire process, PCI will have one of our Regional Directors guide you, pray with you and help you achieve and formulate the necessary steps to see your planning and work conclude in an operating chapter that serves Our Lord Jesus Christ, to His Glory and Honor.
